Amend HB 84 as follows:

(1) Strike Section 2 of the bill (page 2, lines 1-11) and substitute the following appropriately numbered Section:

SECTION _____ . Subchapter M, Chapter 521, Transportation Code, is amended by adding Section 521.2711 to read as follows:

- Sec. 521.2711. LICENSE EXPIRATION: PERSON AT LEAST 85 YEARS

 OF AGE. (a) Each original driver's license of a person 85 years of age or older expires on the license holder's second birthday after the date of the license application.
- (b) A driver's license of a person 85 years of age or older that is renewed expires on the second anniversary of the expiration date before renewal.
 - (2) On page 2, line 16, strike "90" and substitute "85".
- (3) Strike Section 4 of the bill (page 2, line 23 through page 3, line 6), and substitute the following appropriately numbered Section:

SECTION ____ . Section 521.274(b), Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows:

- (b) A rule adopted under this section:
- (1) may prescribe eligibility standards for renewal under this section; $[\frac{and}{a}]$
- (2) may not permit a person subject to the registration requirements under Chapter 62, Code of Criminal Procedure, to register by mail or electronic means; and
- (3) may not permit renewal by mail or electronic means of a driver's license of a person who is 79 years of age or older.
- (4) Strike Section 5 of the bill (page 3, lines 7-17) and substitute the following appropriately numbered Section:

SECTION _____. Section 521.421, Transportation Code, is amended by adding Subsection (i) to read as follows:

- (i) The fee for issuance or renewal of a driver's license is \$8 for a license with an expiration date established under Section 521.2711.
 - (5) Renumber subsequent Sections of the bill accordingly.
