Amend HB 473, Senate committee printing, by inserting the following appropriately numbered SECTIONS in the bill and renumbering subsequent SECTIONS of the bill accordingly:

SECTION \_\_\_\_\_. Section 410.032, Labor Code, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 410.032. PAYMENT OF BENEFITS UNDER INTERLOCUTORY ORDER. (a) The [As designated by the commissioner, division staff, other than the] benefit review officer who presides [presided or will preside] at the benefit review conference[7] shall consider a request for an interlocutory order and shall give the opposing party the opportunity to respond before issuing [issue] an interlocutory order [if determined to be appropriate].

(b) The <u>interlocutory</u> order may address <u>the payment or</u> suspension of accrued benefits, future benefits, or both accrued benefits and future benefits.

SECTION \_\_\_\_\_. Section 410.032, Labor Code, as amended by this Act, applies only to a request for an interlocutory order made in conjunction with a workers' compensation benefit review conference that is conducted by a benefit review officer on or after the effective date of this Act. A request made before that date is governed by the law in effect on the date the request is made, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
