# **BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE**

County clerks are authorized by statute to accept a will for deposit upon payment of a fee. the purpose of this bill is to raise that fee.

## **RULEMAKING AUTHORITY**

It is the committee's opinion that this bill does not expressly grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, department, agency, or institution.

# **ANALYSIS**

The bill would raise the fee for the deposit of a will with the county clerk of the testator's county of residence to five dollars (\$5.00) from three dollars (\$3.00).

# **EFFECTIVE DATE**

Immediately upon receipt of required vote, otherwise September 1, 2007.
