## **BILL ANALYSIS**

H.B. 588 By: Gonzalez Toureilles Law Enforcement Committee Report (Unamended)

## **BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE**

Under current law the court is authorized to dismiss a charge of failure to display valid proof of financial responsibility once the proper documents have been produced.

H.B. 588 would allow the court to charge a dismissal fee, not to exceed \$10, once the court has verified proof of financial responsibility for the motor vehicle.

## **RULEMAKING AUTHORITY**

It is the committee's opinion that this bill does not expressly grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, department, agency, or institution.

## **ANALYSIS**

H.B. 588 amends Section 601.193 (b), Transportation Code, by authorizing the court to assess an administrative fee not to exceed \$10 upon dismissal of a charge of failure to demonstrate financial responsibility.

Section 51.607, Government Code does not apply to this administrative fee.
