### **BILL ANALYSIS**

C.S.S.B. 660 By: Wentworth Judiciary Committee Report (Substituted)

#### **BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE**

Currently, there are seven statutory county courts in Travis County. These courts have experienced enormous growth and a large increase in caseload since the last court was added in 1999.

The bill creates an additional statutory county court in Travis County.

# **RULEMAKING AUTHORITY**

It is the committee's opinion that this bill does not expressly grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, department, agency, or institution.

### **ANALYSIS**

The bill amends the Government code to provide for a newly created county court at law (County Court at Law Number 8) in Travis County. The court will be required to give preference to criminal cases.

### **EFFECTIVE DATE**

September 1, 2008

## **COMPARISON OF ORIGINAL TO SUBSTITUTE**

The substitute deletes a provision of the original bill that would have limited the civil jurisdiction of the court to an amount in controversy of \$100,000 or less.
