A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to making appropriations to the Texas Education Agency for the purpose of school district property tax rate reductions. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. (a) In addition to other amounts appropriated for the Foundation School Program for all or part of the state 6 fiscal biennium ending August 31, 2009, the following amounts are 7 appropriated to the Texas Education Agency under the Foundation 8 School Program for the purpose of funding school district property 9 tax rate reductions in accordance with Section 42.2516, Education 10 11 Code: 12 (1)for the state fiscal year ending August 31, 2008: 13 (A) all amounts in the property tax relief fund 14 (an estimated amount of \$4,231,466,000) are appropriated for this purpose; and 15 if the amounts available from the property 16 (B) tax relief fund for that fiscal year are less than \$6,956,400,000, 17 18 the additional amount necessary for the total appropriation under this subdivision to equal \$6,956,400,000 (an estimated amount of 19 \$2,724,934,000) is appropriated from the foundation school fund for 20 21 this purpose; and 22 (2) for the state fiscal year ending August 31, 2009: 23 (A) all amounts in the property tax relief fund (an estimated amount of \$3,846,492,000) are appropriated for this 24

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1 purpose; and

(B) if the amounts available from the property tax relief fund for that fiscal year are less than \$7,234,700,000, the additional amount necessary for the total appropriation under this subdivision to equal \$7,234,700,000 (an estimated amount of \$3,388,208,000) is appropriated from the foundation school fund for this purpose.

8 (b) In addition to the amounts appropriated under Subsection (a)(2) of this section, any unexpended balance of the 9 amount appropriated for the state fiscal year ending August 31, 10 2008, under Subsection (a)(1) of this section is appropriated to 11 the Texas Education Agency for the purpose described by Subsection 12 (a) of this section for the state fiscal year ending August 31, 13 2009. 14

15 (c) In the event there are insufficient amounts in the property tax relief fund and the foundation school fund to fund the 16 17 entire appropriation under Subsection (a)(1) of this section for the state fiscal year ending August 31, 2008, the commissioner of 18 education may, with the prior approval of the governor and the 19 Legislative Budget Board, transfer amounts appropriated under 20 Subsection (a)(2) of this section for the state fiscal year ending 21 August 31, 2009, in an amount not to exceed the amount necessary to 22 cover the shortfall, and spend the transferred amounts for the 23 24 purpose described by Subsection (a) of this section during the state fiscal year ending August 31, 2008. The comptroller shall: 25

26 (1) transfer money from the general revenue fund or 27 other available sources into the foundation school fund as

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necessary to accomplish an approved transfer of appropriations between fiscal years under this subsection; and (2) reduce the amount that may be appropriated under

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4 Subsection (a)(2) of this section from the foundation school fund 5 accordingly.

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SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.

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
