3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 92, Property Code, is
5	amended by adding Sections 92.018 and 92.019 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 92.018. RIGHT TO VACATE AND AVOID LIABILITY FOLLOWING
7	TENANT'S DEATH. (a) A tenant who dies before the lease term
8	expires is released from any obligation to pay future rent or any
9	other future sums due under the lease if a representative of the
10	tenant's estate or a tenant's family member:
11	(1) removes the tenant's property and otherwise
12	vacates the premises on or before the next date on which rent would
13	be due under the lease;
14	(2) provides timely notice to the landlord of the
15	tenant's death; and
16	(3) otherwise complies with the terms of the lease,
17	including:
18	(A) paying delinquent rent payments and other
19	delinquent amounts due under the lease; and
20	(B) repairing any damage to the premises unless
21	the condition was caused by normal wear and tear.
22	(b) If a representative of the tenant's estate or a tenant's
23	family member fails to vacate the premises or to otherwise comply
24	with the lease agreement as provided by Subsection (a). the

- 1 tenant's estate:
- 2 (1) is liable for rent payments for any period during
- 3 which the premises remain occupied; and
- 4 (2) may be subject to any other penalty imposed by the
- 5 lease.
- 6 (c) A landlord may not impose any penalty, including an
- 7 early move-out or reletting charge or forfeiture of a security
- 8 deposit, for the sole reason of terminating the lease without
- 9 <u>notice after a tenant's death.</u> A lease provision that imposes a
- 10 penalty under the circumstances described by this subsection is
- 11 void.
- 12 Sec. 92.019. LANDLORD'S DUTY TO PROVIDE COPY OF LEASE. A
- 13 landlord shall provide a copy of a written lease agreement to the
- 14 tenant immediately after the lease or any renewal of the lease is
- 15 signed by the landlord and tenant.
- 16 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to a lease agreement
- 17 entered into on or after the effective date of this Act. A lease
- 18 agreement entered into before the effective date of this Act is
- 19 governed by the law in effect at the time the lease agreement was
- 20 entered into, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 21 purpose.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
