- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 365.012(f), Health and Safety Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (f) An offense under this section is a Class A misdemeanor
- 8 if:
- 9 (1) the litter or other solid waste to which the
- offense applies weighs 500 pounds or more but less than 1,000 pounds
- or has a volume of 100 cubic feet or more but less than 200 cubic
- 12 feet; [or]
- 13 (2) the litter or other solid waste is disposed for a
- 14 commercial purpose and weighs more than five pounds but less than
- 15 200 pounds or has a volume of more than five gallons but less than
- 16 200 cubic feet; or
- 17 (3) the litter or other solid waste to which the
- offense applies is a lighted match, a lighted cigarette or cigar, or
- 19 other lighted smoking material discarded from a motor vehicle.
- SECTION 2. (a) Section 365.012(f), Health and Safety Code,
- 21 as amended by this Act, applies only to an offense committed on or
- 22 after September 1, 2007. For purposes of this section, an offense
- is committed before September 1, 2007, if any element of the offense
- 24 occurs before that date.

- 1 (b) An offense committed before September 1, 2007, is
- 2 covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the
- 3 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
