A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to exempting certain sole proprietors from jury duty.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 62.106(a), Government Code, is amended
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 (a) A person qualified to serve as a petit juror may 7 establish an exemption from jury service if the person:
- 8 (1) is over 70 years of age;
- 9 (2) has legal custody of a child younger than 10 years 10 of age and the person's service on the jury requires leaving the
- 11 child without adequate supervision;
- 12 (3) is a student of a public or private secondary
- 13 school;
- 14 (4) is a person enrolled and in actual attendance at an
- 15 institution of higher education;
- 16 (5) is an officer or an employee of the senate, the
- 17 house of representatives, or any department, commission, board,
- 18 office, or other agency in the legislative branch of state
- 19 government;
- 20 (6) is summoned for service in a county with a
- 21 population of at least 200,000, unless that county uses a jury plan
- 22 under Section 62.011 and the period authorized under Section
- 23 62.011(b)(5) exceeds two years, and the person has served as a petit
- juror in the county during the 24-month period preceding the date

- 1 the person is to appear for jury service;
- 2 (7) is the primary caretaker of a person who is an
- 3 invalid unable to care for himself;
- 4 (8) except as provided by Subsection (b), is summoned
- 5 for service in a county with a population of at least 250,000 and
- 6 the person has served as a petit juror in the county during the
- 7 three-year period preceding the date the person is to appear for
- 8 jury service; [or]
- 9 (9) is a member of the United States military forces
- 10 serving on active duty and deployed to a location away from the
- 11 person's home station and out of the person's county of residence;
- 12 or
- 13 (10) is the sole proprietor of a full-time business if
- 14 the business:
- 15 (A) does not have any employees; and
- 16 (B) is not operated primarily over the Internet.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to a person summoned for
- 18 jury duty on or after the effective date of this Act. A person
- 19 summoned for jury duty before the effective date of this Act is
- 20 governed by the law in effect immediately before the effective date
- 21 of this Act, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 22 purpose.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
