- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 2165, Government Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 2165.058 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 2165.058. VENDING MACHINES; ENERGY-SAVING DEVICE
- 9 REQUIRED. (a) This section does not apply to a vending machine
- 10 that contains a perishable food product, as defined by Section
- 11 96.001, Civil Practice and Remedies Code.
- 12 (b) The commission shall require an entity that owns or
- operates a vending machine located in a building owned or leased by
- 14 the state to activate and maintain any internal energy-saving or
- 15 energy-management device or option that is already part of the
- 16 machine or contained <u>in the machine.</u>
- 17 (c) The commission shall require the use of an external
- 18 <u>energy-saving or energy-management device for each vending machine</u>
- 19 <u>that:</u>
- 20 <u>(1) is located in a building</u> owned or leased by the

- 5 (e) The commission may impose an administrative fine on an
- 6 entity that operates a vending machine subject to this section in an
- 7 amount not to exceed \$250 a year for each machine found to be in
- 8 violation of this section or rules adopted by the commission under

- 10 <u>(f) The commission shall adopt rules relating to the</u>

- SECTION 2. Section 2165.058(c), Government Code, as added
- 14 by this Act, applies only to an entity that contracts with the Texas
- 15 Building and Procurement Commission or another state agency to
- install or operate a vending machine on or after the effective date
- of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
