2	relating to the creation of an anti-bullying hotline.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 40, Human Resources Code,
5	is amended by adding Section 40.074 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 40.074. ANTI-BULLYING HOTLINE. (a) From funds
7	appropriated for the purpose or available under Section 40.057, the
8	department shall develop and operate an anti-bullying hotline as
9	provided by this section.
10	(b) The department shall maintain the anti-bullying hotline
11	in association with the department's Texas Youth Hotline.
12	(c) The anti-bullying hotline must enable a primary or
13	secondary school student to report an incident of bullying by:
14	(1) calling a toll-free telephone number; or
15	(2) using an Internet website.
16	(d) To the extent the department considers appropriate, an
17	Internet website maintained under this section may include
18	information regarding prevention of and education concerning
19	unwanted physical or verbal aggression, sexual harassment, and
20	other forms of bullying in school, on school grounds, in school
21	vehicles, at school bus stops, and at school-sponsored or
22	school-related activities.
23	(e) The department shall monitor reports of bullying
24	submitted under this section and forward the reports to:

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1	(1) the principal of the primary or secondary school
2	in which the person accused of bullying is enrolled; or
3	(2) if the person accused of bullying is not enrolled
4	in a primary or secondary school, the local police department or
5	sheriff's office with jurisdiction over the matter.
6	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
