H.B. No. 84

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1
2 relating to issuance and renewal of a driver's license of an elderly
3 person.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 521.271, Transportation Code, is amended
6 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 521.271. LICENSE EXPIRATION. (a) Each original
8 driver's license and provisional license expires as follows:

9 (1) except as provided by Section 521.2711, a driver's
10 license expires on the first birthday of the license holder
11 occurring after the sixth anniversary of the date of the
12 application;

13 (2) a provisional license expires on the earlier of:
14 (A) the 18th birthday of the license holder; or
15 (B) the first birthday of the license holder
16 occurring after the date of the application;

17 (3) an instruction permit expires on the second
18 birthday of the license holder occurring after the date of the
19 application; and

20 (4) an occupational license expires on the first
21 anniversary of the court order granting the license.

22 (b) Except as provided by Section 521.2711, a [A] driver's
23 license that is renewed expires on the sixth anniversary of the
24 expiration date before renewal.

1 SECTION 2. Subchapter M, Chapter 521, Transportation Code,
2 is amended by adding Section 521.2711 to read as follows:

3 Sec. 521.2711. LICENSE EXPIRATION: PERSON AT LEAST 90 YEARS
4 OF AGE. (a) A driver's license expires on the license holder's 90th
5 birthday.

6 (b) An original driver's license of a person older than 90
7 years of age expires on the second anniversary of the date of
8 issuance.

9 (c) A driver's license of a person older than 90 years of age
10 that is renewed expires on the second anniversary of the expiration
11 date before renewal.

12 SECTION 3. Section 521.273, Transportation Code, is
13 amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:

14 (c) The department may not renew a driver's license of a
15 person who on the license's expiration date before renewal is at
16 least 90 years of age unless the person passes an examination for
17 the renewal. The examination must include:

18 (1) a test of the person's vision; and

19 (2) a demonstration of the person's ability to
20 exercise ordinary and reasonable control in the operation of a
21 motor vehicle of the type that the license authorizes the person to
22 operate.

23 SECTION 4. Section 521.274(b), Transportation Code, is
24 amended to read as follows:

25 (b) A rule adopted under this section:

26 (1) may prescribe eligibility standards for renewal
27 under this section; ~~and~~

1 (2) may not permit a person subject to the
2 registration requirements under Chapter 62, Code of Criminal
3 Procedure, to register by mail or electronic means; and

4 (3) may not permit renewal by mail or electronic means
5 of a driver's license of a person who on the license's expiration
6 date before renewal is at least 90 years of age.

7 SECTION 5. Section 521.421, Transportation Code, is
8 amended by adding Subsection (i) to read as follows:

9 (i) The department shall prorate the fee for the issuance or
10 renewal of a driver's license of a person who on the license's
11 expiration date before renewal is at least 85 years of age to
12 account for the expiration of the license on the person's 90th
13 birthday. The fee for issuance or renewal of a driver's license of
14 a person who is at least 90 years of age on the date of issuance or
15 the expiration date before renewal, as applicable, is \$8 for a
16 license with an expiration date established under Section
17 521.2711(b) or (c).

18 SECTION 6. The change in law made by this Act applies only
19 to a driver's license issued or renewed on or after the effective
20 date of this Act.

21 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
