- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 574.045, Health and Safety Code, is
- 5 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsections (a-1) and
- 6 (a-2) to read as follows:
- 7 (a) Except in a county described by Subsection (a-1), the
- 8 [The] court may authorize the transportation of a committed patient
- 9 or a patient detained under Section 573.022 or 574.023 to the
- 10 designated mental health facility by:
- 11 (1) a relative or other responsible person who has a
- 12 proper interest in the patient's welfare and who receives no
- 13 remuneration, except for actual and necessary expenses;
- 14 (2) the facility administrator of the designated
- 15 mental health facility, if the administrator notifies the court
- that facility personnel are available to transport the patient;
- 17 (3) a special officer for mental health assignment
- 18 certified under Section 1701.404, Occupations Code;
- 19 (4) a representative of the local mental health
- 20 authority, who shall be reimbursed by the county; or
- 21 (5) the sheriff or constable, if no person is
- 22 available under Subdivision (1), (2), (3), or (4).
- 23 (a-1) In a county located on the Texas-Mexico border that
- has a population of 500,000 or more and is adjacent to two or more

- 1 counties each of which has a population of 50,000 or more, the court
- 2 may authorize, in the following order of priority, the
- 3 transportation of a committed patient or a patient detained under
- 4 Section 573.022 or 574.023 to the designated mental health facility
- 5 by:
- 6 (1) a relative or other responsible person who has a
- 7 proper interest in the patient's welfare and who receives no
- 8 remuneration, except for actual and necessary expenses;
- 9 (2) the facility administrator of the designated
- 10 mental health facility, unless the administrator notifies the court
- that facility personnel are not available to transport the patient;
- 12 (3) a representative of the local mental health
- authority, who shall be reimbursed by the county;
- 14 (4) a special officer for mental health assignment
- certified under Section 1701.404, Occupations Code, who shall be
- 16 reimbursed by the Department of State Health Services from money
- appropriated for that purpose, or if money is not appropriated for
- that purpose, as provided by Section 571.018; or
- 19 (5) the sheriff or constable, if no person is
- 20 available under Subdivision (1), (2), (3), or (4), who shall be
- 21 reimbursed by the Department of State Health Services from money
- 22 appropriated for that purpose, or if money is not appropriated for
- that purpose, <u>as provided by Section 571.018.</u>
- 24 (a-2) A person who under Subsection (a-1) is authorized by
- 25 the court to transport a patient to a designated mental health
- 26 facility may contract with a third party qualified to provide the
- 27 transportation services authorized by the court.
