- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 92.052(a), Property Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- A landlord shall make a diligent effort to repair or 7
- remedy a condition if: 8
- (1) the tenant specifies the condition in a notice to 9
- the person to whom or to the place where rent is normally paid; 10
- 11 the tenant is not delinquent in the payment of rent
- 12 at the time notice is given; and
- 13 (3) the condition:
- 14 (A) materially affects the physical health or
- safety of an ordinary tenant; or 15
- (B) arises from the landlord's failure to provide 16
- and maintain in good operating condition a device to supply hot 17
- 18 water of a minimum temperature of 120 degrees Fahrenheit.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section 19
- 92.052, Property Code, applies only to a notice under that section 20
- 21 that is made on or after the effective date of this Act. A notice
- under that section made before the effective date of this Act is 22
- governed by the law in effect immediately before that date, and that 23
- law is continued in effect for that purpose. 24
