- 11 (A) \$150 for the issuance or renewal of a
- 12 license, if the ordinance is adopted by the commissioners court of a
- county with a population of one million or more that contains two or
- 14 more municipalities, each of which has a population of 250,000 or
- 15 more; or
- 16 (B) \$1,000 for the issuance or renewal of a
- 17 license, if the ordinance is adopted by the commissioners court of a
- county with a population of 3.3 million or more;
- 19 (3) condition the license on the operation of the
- 20 junkyard or automotive wrecking and salvage yard only at a location
- 21 approved by the commissioners court; or
- 22 (4) establish grounds for suspending or revoking a
- 23 license if the junkyard or automotive wrecking and salvage yard is
- 24 not screened.

- 1 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section
- 2 396.041, Transportation Code, applies only to a license issued or
- 3 renewed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
