Section 31.027 does not apply to a textbook 10 adopted under this section. SECTION 3. Subchapter C, Chapter 31, Education Code, is 11 12 amended by adding Section 31.1011 to read as follows: Sec. 31.1011. TEXTBOOK CREDITS. ## components of such textbooks, including any electronic components. 1 2 SECTION 4. Section 31.1011, Education Code, as added by this Act, applies beginning with the 2007-2008 school year. 3 4 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 6 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2007. 8
