## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1-9 relating to the designation of a portion of Interstate Highway 20 as 1-10 1-11 the Ronald Reagan Memorial Highway.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 225.059(a), Transportation Code, as added by Chapter 284, Acts of the 79th Legislature, Regular 1-12 1-13 Session, 2005, is amended to read as follows: 1-14

1**-**15 1**-**16 (a) <u>Those portions</u> [The part] of Interstate Highway 20 located between the Tarrant-Parker County Line and the eastern municipal boundary of Grand Prairie and between the Dallas-Kaufman 1-17 County Line and the Texas-Louisiana border are [is] designated as 1-18 the Ronald Reagan Memorial Highway. 1-19

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-20 1-21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 1-22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-23 1-24 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
