15	(b) The Commission on Jail Standards shall adopt rules that

17	facility that is not a county jail, including a specific

20	(2) the supervision of prisoners;
21	(3) safety, sanitation, and health;

(6) the space and capacity in the facility; and

2 (7) the enforcement of a rule the commission adopts3 under this subsection.

4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
