8	<u>VETERANS</u> OF UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES. (a) In this section,
9	"veteran" means a person who:
10	(1) has served in:
11	(A) the army, navy, air force, coast guard, or
12	marine corps of the United States;
13	(B) the state military forces as defined by
14	Section 431.001; or
15	(C) an auxiliary service of one of those branches
16	of the armed forces; and
17	(2) has been honorably discharged from the branch of
18	the service in which the person served.
19	(b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this subchapter,
20	the department shall waive [reduce by 50 percent] any fee required

for the issuance of an original, duplicate, modified, or renewed

license under this subchapter if the applicant for the license is a

member or veteran of the United States armed forces, including a

member or veteran of the reserves, national guard, or state guard.
