- 5 SECTION 1. Section 521.142, Transportation Code, is amended
- 6 by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as
- 7 follows:

- 8 (a) An application for an original license must state the
- 9 applicant's full name and place and date of birth. This information
- 10 must be verified by presentation of proof of identity satisfactory
- 11 to the department. The department must accept the following
- 12 <u>documents</u> as satisfactory proof of identity under this subsection:
- 13 (1) an offender identification card or similar form of
- 14 identification issued to an inmate by the Texas Department of
- 15 Criminal Justice; or
- 16 (2) an identity document that is issued by the
- 17 government of another country, if that document bears the
- 18 applicant's photograph, full name, and date of birth and the
- 19 government of the other country has established reasonable
- 20 mechanisms by which the department can verify the identity
- 21 <u>document.</u>
- 22 (a-1) For purposes of Subsection (a)(2), an identity document
- 23 includes a passport, a consular identity document, and a national
- 24 identity document.
