## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the continuing education requirements for a licensed 3 chemical dependency counselor.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 504.205(b), Occupations Code, is amended 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (b) As a prerequisite for renewal of a license issued under
- 8 this chapter, a license holder, other than a license holder subject
- 9 to Subsection (c), must participate in the continuing education
- 10 program and complete [at least 60 hours of] continuing education
- 11 hours in each two-year licensing period as follows:
- 12 (1) 60 hours if the license holder holds an associate
- 13 <u>degree;</u>
- 14 (2) 36 hours if the license holder holds a bachelor's
- 15 degree; and
- 16 (3) 24 hours if the license holder holds a master's
- 17 <u>degree or a more advanced degree</u>.
- SECTION 2. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies to
- 19 the renewal of a license under Chapter 504, Occupations Code, that
- 20 expires on or after January 1, 2008. The renewal of a license that
- 21 expires before that date is governed by the law in effect
- 22 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the former
- 23 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 24 (b) The executive commissioner of the Health and Human

- 1 Services Commission shall adopt rules and the Department of State
- 2 Health Services shall adopt procedures necessary to implement
- 3 Section 504.205(b), Occupations Code, as amended by this Act, not
- 4 later than November 1, 2007.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
