1-9 relating to the eligibility of juvenile correctional officers for  
1-10 the fire fighter and law enforcement or security officer home loan  
1-11 program.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Section 2306.5621(a)(6), Government Code, is  
1-14 amended to read as follows:

1-15 (6) "Corrections officer" means a corrections [an]  
1-16 officer employed by the Texas Department of Criminal Justice or a  
1-17 juvenile correctional officer employed by the Texas Youth  
1-18 Commission.

1-19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-23 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
