- 2 relating to an abortion when a fetal abnormality is detected.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 171.011, Health and Safety Code, is
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 171.011. INFORMED CONSENT REQUIRED. (a) A person may
- 7 not perform an abortion without the voluntary and informed consent
- 8 of the woman on whom the abortion is to be performed.
- 9 <u>(b) If a severe and irreversible abnormality in the fetus is</u>
- 10 detected, a person may obtain the voluntary and informed consent of
- 11 the woman without complying with this subchapter.
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 13 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 14 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 15 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 16 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
