## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to the use of laser sighting devices by hunters who are

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 62.005, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	Sec. 62.005. HUNTING WITH LIGHT. Except as provided by
8	Section 62.0055, no [No] person may hunt a game animal or bird
9	protected by this code with the aid of an artificial light that
10	casts or reflects a beam of light onto or otherwise illuminates the
11	game animal or bird, including the headlights of a motor vehicle.
12	SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 62, Parks and Wildlife
13	Code, is amended by adding Section 62.0055 to read as follows:

- 14 Sec. 62.0055. HUNTING WITH LASER SIGHTING DEVICE BY LEGALLY
- 15 BLIND HUNTER. (a) In this section, "legally blind" has the meaning
- assigned by Section 62.104, Government Code.
- 17 <u>(b) A legally blind hunter may use a laser sighting device</u>
  18 <u>during regular hunting hours when assisted by a person who:</u>
- 19 <u>(1) is not legally blind;</u>
- 20 (2) has a hunting license; and
- 21 (3) is at least 13 years of age.
- (c) The legally blind hunter must carry proof of being
- 23 legally blind.
- 24 (d) Section 62.014 applies to a hunter under this section.

- 1 SECTION 3. (a) Not later than September 1, 2007, the Parks
- 2 and Wildlife Commission shall adopt rules that prescribe what is
- 3 acceptable as proof of being legally blind under Section 62.0055,
- 4 Parks and Wildlife Code, as added by this Act.
- 5 (b) The Parks and Wildlife Department may not enforce
- 6 Section 62.0055(c), Parks and Wildlife Code, as added by this Act,
- 7 until the rules adopted under Subsection (a) of this section take
- 8 effect.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
