Section 21(c), Article 42.12, Code of Criminal Procedure, is amended to read as follows: 7 (c) In a community supervision revocation hearing at which 8 it is alleged only that the defendant violated the conditions of 9 community supervision by failing to pay compensation paid to 10 appointed counsel, community supervision fees, or court costs, 11 [restitution, or reparations,] the state must prove by a 12 preponderance of the evidence that [inability of] the defendant was 13 14 able to pay and did not pay as ordered by the judge [is an affirmative defense to revocation, which the defendant must prove 15 by a preponderance of evidence]. 16 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 17 to a community supervision revocation hearing held on or after the 18

19 effective date of this Act.
