A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the career ladder for certain prison industry workers.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 493.007, Government Code, is amended by
- 5 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (e) to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 (a) The executive director shall develop an intraagency
- 8 career ladder program. The career ladder program developed for
- 9 correctional officers under this subsection shall also include
- 10 prison industry workers. The program shall require intraagency
- 11 postings of all nonentry level positions concurrently with any
- 12 public postings.
- (e) In this section, "prison industry worker" means a
- 14 department employee, other than a correctional officer, who is
- assigned to work on a program or project established under Chapter
- 16 497 and whose job on a regular basis requires routine contact with
- 17 state jail defendants or inmates confined in facilities operated by
- 18 or under contract with the department. The term includes a farm
- 19 manager, livestock supervisor, maintenance foreman, shop foreman,
- 20 medical assistant, food service supervisor, steward, education
- 21 consultant, commodity specialist, truck driver, or correctional
- 22 counselor.
- 23 SECTION 2. The Texas Department of Criminal Justice must
- use the career ladder program developed under Section 493.007(a),

- 1 Government Code, as amended by this Act, for any person who becomes
- 2 employed by the department as a prison industry worker or who
- 3 becomes eligible for promotion by the department as a prison
- 4 industry worker on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
