Consent under this 16 subsection must be on a separate document, signed by the license or 17 18 certificate holder, that explains in at least 14-point bold type the information that will be included in the compilation or 19 For the purposes of this subsection, "financial database. 20 21 institution" has the meaning assigned by 31 U.S.C. Section 5312(a)(2), as amended. 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007. 23
