3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Sections 426.001(b) and (c), Property Code, are
5	amended to read as follows:
6	(b) This subtitle does not apply to a dispute:
7	(1) arising out of:
8	(A) [ $(1)$ ] an alleged violation of Section 27.01,
9	Business & Commerce Code;
10	(B) $[(2)$ a builder's wrongful abandonment of an
11	improvement project before completion; or
12	(C) [ $(3)$ ] a violation of Chapter 162; or
13	(2) in which:
14	(A) the builder or any subcontractor employs an
15	undocumented worker for the construction project that is the
16	subject of the dispute; and
17	(B) the builder has registered 100 homes or more
18	with the commission during the commission's previous fiscal year.
19	(c) For the purposes of this section:
20	(1) "Damage [, "damage] to goods" does not include
21	damage to a home.
22	(2) "Undocumented worker" means a person who is not
23	lawfully entitled to be present and employed in the United States.
24	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
