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A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT relating to the provision of free notary public service by 2 3 applicants for an allocation of low income housing tax credits. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 2306.6710(b), Government Code, is 6 amended to read as follows: If an application satisfies the threshold criteria, the 7 (b) department shall score and rank the application using a point 8 9 system that: (1) prioritizes descending 10 in order criteria 11 regarding: 12 (A) financial feasibility of the development 13 based on the supporting financial data required in the application 14 that will include a project underwriting pro forma from the permanent or construction lender; 15 quantifiable community participation with 16 (B) respect to the development, evaluated on the basis of written 17 statements from any neighborhood organizations on record with the 18 state or county in which the development is to be located and whose 19 boundaries contain the proposed development site; 20 21 (C) the income levels of tenants of the 22 development; the size and quality of the units; 23 (D) 24 the commitment of development funding by (E)

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local political subdivisions;

2 (F) the level of community support for the 3 application, evaluated on the basis of written statements from 4 state elected officials;

5 (G) the rent levels of the units;

6 (H) the cost of the development by square foot;7 and

8 (I) the services to be provided to tenants of the
9 development; [and]

10 (2) uses criteria imposing penalties on applicants or affiliates who have requested extensions of department deadlines 11 12 relating to developments supported by housing tax credit allocations made in the application round preceding the current 13 14 round or a developer or principal of the applicant that has been 15 removed by the lender, equity provider, or limited partners for its failure to perform its obligations under the loan documents or 16 17 limited partnership agreement; and

18 (3) encourages applicants to provide free notary 19 public service to the residents of the developments for which the 20 allocation of housing tax credits is requested.

21 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act relating to the evaluation of applications for financial 22 assistance administered by the Texas Department of Housing and Community 23 24 Affairs apply only to an application submitted on or after the 25 effective date of this Act. An application submitted before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect when the 26 application was submitted, and the former law is continued in 27

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effect for that purpose.
 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
