- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 52.047(a), Government Code, is amended 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A person may apply for a transcript of the evidence in a 8 case reported by an official court reporter. The person must apply
- 9 for the transcript in writing to the official court reporter. The
- 10 <u>official court</u>[, and the] reporter shall furnish the transcript to

the person not later than the 120th day after the date the:

- 12 <u>(1)</u> application for the transcript is received by the
- 13 reporter; and

- 14 (2) [on payment of the] transcript fee is paid or the
- 15 person establishes indigency as provided by Rule 20 [40(a)(3) or
- 16 $\frac{53(j)}{}$], Texas Rules of Appellate Procedure.
- 17 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section
- 18 52.047, Government Code, applies only to an application request for
- 19 a transcript made on or after the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
