- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 814.103, Government Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 814.103. SERVICE RETIREMENT BENEFITS FOR ELECTED CLASS
- 8 SERVICE. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b), the standard
- 9 service retirement annuity for service credited in the elected
- 10 class of membership is an amount equal to the number of years of
- 11 service credit in that class, times \underline{six} [\underline{two}] percent of the $\underline{average}$
- 12 [state] salary, as adjusted from time to time, being paid \underline{a}
- 13 <u>full-time public school teacher in this state</u>, as determined by the
- 14 Texas Education Agency [a district judge].
- 15 (b) The standard service retirement annuity for service
- 16 credited in the elected class may not exceed at any time 200 [100]
- 17 percent of the average [state] salary being paid a full-time public
- 18 <u>school teacher in this state</u> [a district judge].
- 19 SECTION 2. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
- only to an annuity payment under Section 814.103, Government Code,
- 21 as amended by this Act, made on or after September 1, 2007.
- 22 (b) The Employees Retirement System of Texas shall
- 23 recompute an annuity that first became payable before September 1,
- 24 2007, as though Section 814.103, Government Code, as amended by

- 1 this Act, were in effect on the date the annuity first became
- 2 payable.
- 3 (c) The first payment of the recomputed annuity is payable
- 4 on the first payment date occurring on or after September 1, 2007.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
