- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 11.22(a), Tax Code, is amended to read as

- SECTION 2. Section 11.22(a), Tax Code, as amended by this 19
- Act, applies only to ad valorem taxation for a tax year that begins 20
- 21 on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2008, but only
- if the constitutional amendment proposed by the 80th Legislature, 23
- Regular Session, 2007, to authorize a change in the manner of 24

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- 1 determining the amount of the exemption from ad valorem taxation to
- 2 which a disabled veteran is entitled is approved by the voters. If
- 3 that amendment is not approved by the voters, this Act has no
- 4 effect.
