- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 1802.002, Occupations Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1802.002. APPLICABILITY. This chapter does not apply
- 8 to:
- 9 (1) a sale conducted by order of a United States court
- 10 under Title 11, United States Code;
- 11 (2) a sale conducted by an employee of the United
- 12 States, this state, or a political subdivision of this state in the
- 13 course and scope of employment;
- 14 (3) a sale conducted by a charitable, religious, or
- 15 civic [or nonprofit] organization, including an organization
- having a tax exempt status under Section 501(c), Internal Revenue
- 17 Code of 1986, or organized as a nonprofit entity, if the person
- 18 <u>conducting the auction</u> [auctioneer] receives no compensation;
- 19 (4) a sale conducted by an individual of the
- 20 individual's property if the individual is not engaged in the
- 21 business of selling property as an auctioneer on a recurring basis;
- 22 (5) a foreclosure sale of real property personally
- 23 conducted by a trustee under a deed of trust;
- 24 (6) a foreclosure sale of personal property personally

- 2 (A) a person who holds a security interest in the

- 4 (B) an employee or agent of a person described by

- 27 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
