3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. The heading for Chapter 2305, Occupations Code,
5	is amended to read as follows:
6	CHAPTER 2305. [RECORDS OF] CERTAIN VEHICLE REPAIRS, SALES, AND
7	PURCHASES
8	SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 2305, Occupations Code, is
9	amended by adding Section 2305.008 to read as follows:
10	Sec. 2305.008. DISCLOSURE OF VEHICLE CONDITION; RIGHT TO
11	INDEPENDENT INSPECTION. (a) A person engaged in the business of
12	selling used motor vehicles shall provide a potential purchaser of
13	a used motor vehicle a complete and detailed statement of the
14	vehicle's condition. The statement must include a list of any known
15	problems or defects affecting the vehicle's mechanical system,
16	tires, brakes, and any other defect that substantially affects the
17	vehicle's use, value, or safety.
18	(b) A person engaged in the business of selling used motor
19	vehicles shall permit a potential purchaser of a used motor vehicle
20	to arrange for the reasonable inspection of the vehicle, including
21	an inspection to be conducted away from the premises where the
22	vehicle is offered for sale. This subsection does not prohibit the
23	seller of the vehicle from imposing reasonable conditions on the

time, place, and manner of the inspection.
