2	relating to the appointment of magistrates in McLennan County.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Chapter 54, Government Code, is amended by
5	adding Subchapter CC to read as follows:
6	SUBCHAPTER CC. MAGISTRATES IN MCLENNAN COUNTY
7	Sec. 54.1511. APPOINTMENT. The Commissioners Court of
8	McLennan County may appoint one or more magistrates to perform the
9	duties authorized by this subchapter.
10	Sec. 54.1512. QUALIFICATION. To be eligible for
11	appointment as a magistrate, a person must be a resident of McLennan
12	<u>County</u> , Texas.
13	Sec. 54.1513. JUDICIAL IMMUNITY. A magistrate has the same
14	judicial immunity as a district judge.
15	Sec. 54.1514. POWERS. Subject to the standing orders of the
16	Commissioners Court of McLennan County, the magistrate may:
17	(1) investigate applications for personal bonds; and
18	(2) issue personal bonds to qualified defendants.
19	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
20	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
21	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
22	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
23	Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
