5	SECTION 1. Section 107.45, Education Code, is amended to
6	read as follows:
7	Sec. 107.45. EMINENT DOMAIN <u>;</u> [+] RESTRICTION. <u>(a) The</u>
8	board of regents has the power of eminent domain to acquire for the
9	use of the university in the manner prescribed by Chapter 21,
10	Property Code, any real property that may be necessary and proper
11	for carrying out its purposes.
12	(b) The taking of real property by the board under this
13	section is declared to be for the use of this state. The board is
14	not required to deposit a bond or the amount equal to the award of
15	damages by the commissioners as provided by Section 21.021,
16	Property Code.
17	(c) The board may not use the power of eminent domain to
18	acquire <u>real property</u> [land] that is dedicated to a public use by
19	another governmental entity.
20	SECTION 2. Chapter 127, Acts of the 48th Legislature,
21	Regular Session, 1943 (Article 3264d, Vernon's Texas Civil
22	Statutes), is repealed.
23	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
24	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
