- 2 relating to the possible development of a plan to reregulate the
- 3 electric market in this state.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. (a) The Public Utility Commission of Texas shall
- 6 develop a plan to reregulate the production and sale of electricity
- 7 if, on July 1, 2007, the average price for average residential use
- 8 of electricity in ERCOT is greater than the average price for
- 9 average residential use of electricity in the United States.
- 10 (b) The plan required by Subsection (a) of this section must
- 11 include:
- 12 (1) possible methods to reverse the restructuring of
- the electric utility industry made by Chapter 405, Acts of the 76th
- 14 Legislature, Regular Session, 1999;
- 15 (2) an evaluation of the effect on residential
- 16 electricity prices of each method; and
- 17 (3) necessary legislative changes to implement each
- 18 method.
- 19 (c) Not later than January 5, 2009, the Public Utility
- 20 Commission of Texas shall deliver the plan to the governor, the
- 21 lieutenant governor, and the electric utility restructuring
- 22 legislative oversight committee.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
