## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT relating to the additional exit conference required following inspection, survey, or investigation of certain facilities. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Sections 242.0445(b) and (c), Health and Safety Code, are amended to read as follows: (b) At the conclusion of an inspection, survey, or investigation under Section 242.043 or 242.044, the department or the department's representative conducting the inspection, survey, or investigation shall discuss the violations with the facility's management in an exit conference. The department or the

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12 department's representative shall leave a written list of the 13 violations with the facility at the time of the exit conference. If 14 the department or the department's representative discovers any additional violations during the review of field notes 15 or preparation of the official final list, the department or the 16 department's representative shall give the facility an additional 17 18 exit conference regarding the additional violations. An additional exit conference must be held in person and may not be held by 19 telephone, e-mail, or fax. 20

21 (c) The facility shall submit a plan to correct the 22 violations to the regional director not later than the 10th working day after the date the facility receives the final official 23 statement of violations. 24

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1 SECTION 2. Section 247.0271, Health and Safety Code, is 2 amended by amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection (d) to 3 read as follows:

4 (c) If, after the initial exit conference, additional
5 violations are cited, the inspector shall conduct an additional
6 exit conference regarding the newly identified violations. <u>An</u>
7 <u>additional exit conference must be held in person and may not be</u>
8 <u>held by telephone, e-mail, or fax.</u>

9 (d) The assisted living facility shall submit a plan of 10 correction to the regional director with supervisory authority over 11 the inspector not later than the 10th working day after the date the 12 facility receives the final official statement of violations.

SECTION 3. Sections 252.044(b) and (c), Health and Safety
Code, are amended to read as follows:

15 (b) At the conclusion of an inspection, survey, or department or 16 investigation under this chapter, the the 17 department's representative conducting the inspection, survey, or investigation shall discuss the violations with the facility's 18 management in an exit conference. 19 The department or the department's representative shall leave a written list of the 20 violations with the facility and the person designated by the 21 facility to receive notice under Section 252.066 at the time of the 22 exit conference. If 23 the department or the department's 24 representative discovers any additional violations during the 25 review of field notes or preparation of the official final list, the department or the department's representative shall give the 26 facility an additional exit conference regarding the additional 27

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1	violations. An additional exit conference must be held in person
2	and may not be held by telephone, e-mail, or fax.
3	(c) The facility shall submit a plan to correct the
4	violations to the regional director not later than the 10th working
5	day after the date the facility receives the final official
6	statement of violations.
7	SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.

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
