A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to the instructional requirements for education services
3	provided in a juvenile residential facility operated by a juvenile
4	board or under contract with the Texas Youth Commission.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 37, Education Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 37.0062 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 37.0062. INSTRUCTIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR ALTERNATIVE
9	EDUCATION SERVICES IN JUVENILE RESIDENTIAL FACILITIES. (a) The
10	commissioner shall determine the instructional requirements for
11	education services provided by a school district or open-enrollment
12	charter school in a pre-adjudication secure detention facility or a
13	post-adjudication secure correctional facility operated by a
14	juvenile board or a post-adjudication secure correctional facility
15	operated under contract with the Texas Youth Commission, including
16	requirements relating to:
17	(1) the length of the school day;
18	(2) the number of days of instruction provided to
19	students each school year; and
20	(3) the curriculum of the educational program.
21	(b) The commissioner shall coordinate with:
22	(1) the Texas Juvenile Probation Commission in
23	determining the instructional requirements for education services
24	provided under Subsection (a) in a pre-adjudication secure

- 1 detention facility or a post-adjudication secure correctional
- 2 facility operated by a juvenile board; and
- 3 (2) the Texas Youth Commission in determining the
- 4 instructional requirements for education services provided under
- 5 Subsection (a) in a post-adjudication secure correctional facility
- 6 operated under contract with the Texas Youth Commission.
- 7 <u>(c) The commissioner shall adopt rules necessary to</u>
- 8 administer this section. The rules must ensure that:
- 9 (1) a student who receives education services in a
- 10 pre-adjudication secure detention facility described by this
- 11 section is offered courses that enable the student to maintain
- 12 progress toward completing high school graduation requirements;
- 13 and
- 14 (2) a student who receives education services in a
- 15 post-adjudication secure correctional facility described by this
- section is offered, at a minimum, the courses necessary to enable
- 17 the student to complete high school graduation requirements.
- 18 (d) The Texas Juvenile Probation Commission or the Texas
- 19 Youth Commission, as applicable, shall coordinate with the
- 20 commissioner in establishing standards for:
- 21 (1) ensuring security in the provision of education
- 22 services in the facilities; and
- 23 (2) providing children in the custody of the
- 24 facilities access to education services.
- 25 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- of this Act, the commissioner of education by rule shall determine
- 27 the instructional requirements for education services provided by a

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- 1 school district or open-enrollment charter school in a
- 2 pre-adjudication or post-adjudication juvenile residential
- 3 facility, as required by Section 37.0062, Education Code, as added
- 4 by this Act.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
