A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to prohibiting mandatory participation in an animal
- 3 identification system.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 161.056(a), (c), and (d), Agriculture
- 6 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) In order to provide for disease control and enhance the
- 8 ability to trace disease-infected animals or animals that have been
- 9 exposed to disease, the commission may develop and implement a
- 10 voluntary [an] animal identification program that is consistent
- 11 with the United States Department of Agriculture's National Animal
- 12 Identification System.
- 13 (c) The commission may permit [require] the use of official
- 14 identification numbers assigned as part of the animal
- 15 identification program for animal disease control, animal
- 16 emergency management, and other commission programs.
- 17 (d) The commission may establish a date by which all
- 18 participating premises must be registered and may assess a
- 19 registration fee on all entities that register for a premises
- 20 identification number.
- 21 SECTION 2. Sections 161.056(g) and (h), Agriculture Code,
- 22 are repealed.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
