4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 1302.002, Occupations Code, is amended
6	by adding Subdivisions (5-a), (5-b), and (17) to read as follows:
7	(5-a) "Air conditioning and refrigeration technician"
8	means a person who assists a licensed air conditioning and
9	refrigeration contractor in performing air conditioning and
10	refrigeration maintenance work.
11	(5-b) "Certified technician" means a registered
12	technician who has completed a certification examination.
13	(17) "Registered technician" means an air
14	conditioning and refrigeration technician who is registered with
15	the department.
16	SECTION 2. Section 1302.101, Occupations Code, is amended
17	by adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:
18	(e) The department may examine any criminal conviction,
19	guilty plea, or deferred adjudication of an applicant for issuance
20	or renewal of a license, including by obtaining any criminal
21	history record information permitted by law.
22	SECTION 3. Section 1302.263, Occupations Code, is amended
23	to read as follows:
24	Sec. 1302.263. LIMITATION ON LICENSE HOLDER OR REGISTERED

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1 TECHNICIAN. A person licensed under this chapter may not: 2 (1) perform or offer or attempt to perform an act, 3 service, or function that is: (A) [(1)] defined as the practice of engineering 4 5 under Chapter 1001, unless the person holds a license under that 6 chapter; 7 (B) [(2)] regulated under Chapter 113, Natural 8 Resources Code, unless the person holds a license or is exempt by rule under that chapter; or 9 10 (C) [(3)] defined as plumbing under Chapter 1301, unless the person holds a license under that chapter; or 11 12 (2) use the services of a person who is not a registered technician or a licensed air conditioning and 13 14 refrigeration contractor to assist in the performance of air 15 conditioning and refrigeration maintenance work. SECTION 4. Section 1302.401(a), Occupations Code, 16 is 17 amended to read as follows: A person is subject to the denial of an application, 18 (a) 19 imposition of an administrative penalty under Subchapter F, Chapter 51, or disciplinary action under Section 51.353 if the person: 20 21 (1) violates this chapter or a rule adopted under this chapter; or 22 (2) violates [is convicted of an offense under] a 23 24 municipal ordinance adopted under Section 1302.303. SECTION 5. Section 1302.402, Occupations Code, is amended 25 26 to read as follows: Sec. 1302.402. ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEDURES. A proceeding for 27

the denial of a license or registration application or disciplinary 1 2 action and an appeal from that proceeding are governed by Chapter 2001, Government Code. 3 4 SECTION 6. Chapter 1302, Occupations Code, is amended by 5 adding Subchapter K to read as follows: 6 SUBCHAPTER K. AIR CONDITIONING AND REFRIGERATION TECHNICIANS Sec. 1302.501. REGISTRATION REQUIRED. (a) A person may not 7 act or offer to act as an air conditioning and refrigeration 8 9 technician unless the person is registered under this subchapter. (b) A registration is valid throughout the state. 10 Sec. 1302.502. RULES. The executive director shall adopt 11 12 rules: (1) providing for the registration of technicians as 13 14 prescribed by this subchapter; and 15 (2) establishing fees for issuance and renewal of a registration. 16 17 Sec. 1302.503. SUPERVISION REQUIREMENTS FOR REGISTRANTS. An air conditioning and refrigeration technician must be supervised 18 19 by an air conditioning and refrigeration contractor licensed under this chapter. 20 21 Sec. 1302.504. APPLICATION; FEE. (a) An applicant for registration must submit an application on a form prescribed by the 22 commission. 23 24 (b) The completed application must be accompanied by the 25 application fee. Sec. 1302.505. ISSUANCE AND TERM OF REGISTRATION. (a) On 26 receipt of a completed application, the department shall register 27

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1	an applicant who meets the requirements of this subchapter.
2	(b) A registration is valid for one year from the date of
3	issuance.
4	Sec. 1302.506. TEMPORARY REGISTRATION. (a) An applicant
5	for registration may request a temporary registration. The
6	executive director shall issue a temporary registration that
7	expires on the 21st day after the date of issuance to an applicant
8	who meets the qualifications for temporary registration.
9	(b) The commission shall adopt rules providing for the
10	issuance of a temporary registration under this section, including
11	the qualifications and fee required for the registration.
12	Sec. 1302.507. RENEWAL OF REGISTRATION. To renew a
13	registration, a registered technician must:
14	(1) submit a renewal request on a form prescribed by
15	the executive director; and
16	(2) pay the required renewal fee.
17	Sec. 1302.508. CERTIFIED TECHNICIAN. A registered
18	technician may be certified by the department and use the
19	designation "certified technician" if the registered technician:
20	(1) completes an application for certification on a
21	form prescribed by the executive director;
22	(2) pays the application fee; and
23	(3) provides the department with proof that the
24	registered technician successfully completed a nationally
25	recognized and administered certification examination or another
26	examination of equal or greater difficulty approved by the
27	department.

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1 SECTION 7. Not later than December 31, 2007, the Texas 2 Commission of Licensing and Regulation shall adopt rules 3 implementing Subchapter K, Chapter 1302, Occupations Code, as added 4 by this Act.

5 SECTION 8. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of this 6 section, this Act takes effect September 1, 2007.

7 (b) Sections 1302.501 and 1302.503, Occupations Code, as
8 added by this Act, take effect June 30, 2008.
