1-8 AN ACT

1-9 relating to the designation of a portion of United States Highway  
1-10 287 as the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., Freeway.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,  
1-13 is amended by adding Section 225.066 to read as follows:

1-14 Sec. 225.066. DR. MARTIN LUTHER KING, JR., FREEWAY. (a)  
1-15 The part of United States Highway 287 south of State Highway 180 to  
1-16 its intersection with Interstate Highway 820 in Tarrant County is  
1-17 designated as the Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., Freeway.

1-18 (b) The department shall design and construct memorial  
1-19 markers indicating the highway number, the designation as the Dr.  
1-20 Martin Luther King, Jr., Freeway, and any other appropriate  
1-21 information.

1-22 (c) The department shall erect a marker at each end of the  
1-23 highway and at appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

1-24 (d) The department is not required to design, construct, or  
1-25 erect a marker under this section unless the department receives a  
1-26 grant or donation to cover the cost of the design, construction, and  
1-27 erection.

1-28 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
