7	Sec. 550.027. PASSENGER'S DUTY TO RENDER AID. (a) The	
8	passenger of a vehicle involved in an accident commits an offense	
9	<u>if:</u>	
10	(1) a reasonable person would believe that bodily	
11	injury or death may have resulted from the accident;	
12	(2) the passenger fails to provide any person injured	
13	in the accident reasonable assistance, including transporting or	
14	making arrangements for transporting the person to a physician or	
15	hospital for medical treatment if it is apparent that treatment is	
16	necessary, or if the injured person requests the transportation;	
17	and	
18	(3) the passenger could assist the person without	
19	placing the passenger in danger of suffering serious bodily injury	
20	or death.	
21	(b) An offense under this section is punishable by:	
22	(1) imprisonment in the institutional division of the	
23	Texas Department of Criminal Justice for not more than five years or

confinement in the county jail for not more than one year;

1	(2) a fine not to exceed \$5,000; or
2	(3) both the fine and the imprisonment or confinement.
3	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
