- 2 relating to health education curriculum and instruction in public
- 3 schools.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 28.004(e), Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (e) Any course materials and instruction relating to human
- 8 sexuality, sexually transmitted diseases, or human
- 9 immunodeficiency virus or acquired immune deficiency syndrome
- 10 shall be selected by the board of trustees with the advice of the
- 11 local school health advisory council and must:
- 12 (1) provide a clear understanding of abstinence from
- 13 <u>sexual activity and engaging in sexual activity;</u>
- 14 (2) include strategies to promote effective
- 15 communication between adolescents and their parents and family
- 16 members about human sexuality;
- 17 <u>(3)</u> present abstinence from sexual activity as the
- 18 preferred choice of behavior in relationship to all sexual activity
- 19 for unmarried persons of school age;
- 20 $\underline{(4)}$ [$\underline{(2)}$] devote more attention to abstinence from
- 21 sexual activity than to any other behavior;
- 22 (5) for circumstances in which a student is unable to
- 23 <u>abstain from sexual activity</u>, analyze the benefits of a healthy and
- 24 monogamous sexual relationship and provide detailed information

- 1 about local agencies that provide relationship support and
- 2 counseling;
- 3 (6) $\left[\frac{(3)}{(3)}\right]$ emphasize that abstinence from sexual
- 4 activity, if used consistently and correctly, is the only method
- 5 that is 100 percent effective in preventing pregnancy, sexually
- 6 transmitted diseases, infection with human immunodeficiency virus,
- 7 <u>and</u> [or] acquired immune deficiency syndrome, and <u>is the preferred</u>
- 8 <u>method to prevent any</u> [the] emotional trauma that may be associated
- 9 with adolescent sexual activity;
- 10 $\underline{(7)}$ [$\frac{(4)}{(4)}$] direct adolescents to a standard of behavior
- in which abstinence from sexual activity before marriage is the
- 12 most effective way to prevent pregnancy, sexually transmitted
- 13 diseases, [and] infection with human immunodeficiency virus, and
- 14 [or] acquired immune deficiency syndrome; [and]
- 15 (8) for circumstances in which a student is unable to
- 16 <u>abstain from sexual activity, provide detailed information on</u>
- 17 testing for and preventing transmission of sexually transmitted
- 18 diseases;
- (9) $[\frac{(5)}{}]$ teach contraception and condom use in a
- 20 medically accurate manner that addresses the health benefits of
- 21 <u>contraception and condom use and the</u> [terms of] human use reality
- 22 rates instead of theoretical laboratory rates, if instruction on
- 23 contraception and condoms is included in curriculum content;
- 24 (10) address the legal rights of victims of sexual
- 25 assault, including sexual abuse, and identify local agencies that
- 26 assist victims of sexual assault or that work to prevent sexual
- 27 assault;

- 1 (11) address the economic and emotional requirements
- 2 of fatherhood; and
- 3 (12) describe local services available to students who
- 4 are unable to abstain from sexual activity, including services for
- 5 adolescents who are pregnant or need postnatal medical care, child
- 6 care, or educational services.
- 7 SECTION 2. A school district that uses textbooks or other
- 8 course materials that do not reflect the requirements prescribed by
- 9 Section 28.004(e), Education Code, as amended by this Act, shall
- 10 also use appropriate supplemental instructional materials as
- 11 necessary to comply with those requirements.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2007-2008
- 13 school year.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
