SECTION 2. (a) The amendment made by this Act to Section 17 18 867(b-1), Texas Probate Code, is intended to clarify, rather than change, existing law. 19 20 A court in which an application for the creation of a (b) 21 management trust under Section 867, Texas Probate Code, is pending 22 on the effective date of this Act and that is not a probate court, as defined by Section 601, Texas Probate Code, shall transfer the 23

proceeding to a proper probate court, as defined by that section.

When a proceeding is transferred from one court to another as 1 2 provided by this subsection, all processes, writs, bonds, 3 recognizances, or other obligations issued from the transferring 4 court are returnable to the court to which the proceeding is transferred as if originally issued by that court. The obligees in 5 6 all bonds and recognizances taken in and for a court from which a proceeding is transferred, and all witnesses summoned to appear in 7 8 a court from which a proceeding is transferred, are required to appear before the court to which a proceeding is transferred as if 9 originally required to appear before the court to which the 10 transfer is made. 11
