5 SECTION 1. Section 41.45(e), Tax Code, is amended to read as

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7 (e) On request made to the appraisal review board before the

date of the hearing, the property owner is entitled to one

postponement of the hearing to a later date without showing cause.

10 <u>In addition and without limitation as to the number of</u>

postponements, the $[rac{The}{}]$ board shall postpone the hearing to a

later date if the property owner or the owner's agent at any time

shows <u>reasonable</u> [good] cause for the postponement or if the chief

appraiser consents to the postponement. The hearing may not be

postponed to a date less than five or more than $30 \ [15]$ days after

the date scheduled for the [original] hearing when the postponement

17 <u>is sought</u> unless the date and time of the hearing as postponed are

agreed to by the appraisal review board, the property owner, and the

19 chief appraiser. A request by a property owner for a postponement

20 under this subsection is not required to be in writing, and the

granting by the board of a postponement [Postponement] under this

subsection does not require the delivery of additional written

23 notice to the property owner.

SECTION 2. Section 41.46(a), Tax Code, is amended to read as

- 2 (a) The appraisal review board before which a protest
- 3 hearing is scheduled shall deliver written notice to the property
- 4 owner initiating a protest of the date, time, and place fixed for
- 5 the hearing on the protest and of the property owner's entitlement
- 6 to a postponement of the hearing as provided by Section 41.45 unless
- 7 the property owner waives in writing notice of the hearing. The
- 8 board shall deliver the notice not later than the 15th day before
- 9 the date of the hearing.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act applies only to a protest notice of
- 11 which is filed with an appraisal review board on or after the
- 12 effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
