- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 1551.1021(a), Insurance Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 (a) An adjunct faculty member at a public institution of
- 9 higher education is eligible to participate in the group benefits
- 10 program as an employee if the faculty member:
- 11 (1) receives compensation for services rendered to a
- 12 public institution of higher education as an adjunct faculty
- 13 member;
- 14 (2) has been employed as a faculty member by the same
- 15 public institution of higher education and has taught at least one
- 16 course in each regular fall and spring semester at the public
- institution of higher education in [each of] the preceding [three]
- 18 academic <u>year</u> [years]; and
- 19 (3) is under contract or is scheduled to teach at least
- 20 $\underline{\text{nine}}$ [$\frac{12}{1}$] semester credit hours in the academic year of coverage or,
- 21 if the person is also employed by the public institution of higher
- 22 education to perform nonteaching duties, is under contract or is
- 23 scheduled to teach at least six semester credit hours in the
- 24 academic year of coverage and has been approved by the public

- 3 SECTION 2. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
- 4 only to coverage for an academic year that begins on or after
- 5 December 1, 2007.
- 6 (b) The board of trustees of the Employees Retirement System
- 7 of Texas shall include coverage under Section 1551.1021, Insurance
- 8 Code, as amended by this Act, in an insurance policy or contract or
- 9 in an evidence of coverage delivered, issued for delivery, or
- 10 renewed on or after January 1, 2008. The board of trustees may
- 11 include coverage under Section 1551.1021, Insurance Code, as
- 12 amended by this Act, in an insurance policy or contract or in an
- 13 evidence of coverage delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed
- 14 before January 1, 2008, if the board of trustees determines that
- 15 coverage may be reasonably included.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
