The change in law made by this Act applies 20 21 beginning with tuition and fees for the 2007 fall semester. Tuition 22 and fees for a term or semester before the 2007 fall semester are covered by the law in effect immediately before the effective date 23 of this Act, and the former law is continued in effect for that 24
