- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 25.085(e), Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (e) A person who voluntarily enrolls in school or
- 8 voluntarily attends school after the person's 18th birthday shall
- 9 attend school each school day for the entire period the program of
- instruction is offered, and shall attend until the end of the school
- 11 year. Section 25.094 applies to a person described by this
- 12 <u>subsection</u>. Sections 25.093 and 25.095 do not apply to the parent
- of a person described by this subsection. [A school district may
- 14 revoke for the remainder of the school year the enrollment of a
- 15 person who has more than five absences in a semester that are not
- 16 excused under Section 25.087. A person whose enrollment is revoked
- 17 under this subsection may be considered an unauthorized person on
- 18 school district grounds for purposes of Section 37.107.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2007-2008
- 20 school year.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
