- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 160.415, Family Code, is amended to read
- 6 as follows:
- 7 Sec. 160.415. UNTIMELY REGISTRATION. If a man registers
- 8 later than the 31st [30th] day after the date of the birth of the
- 9 child, the bureau of vital statistics shall notify the registrant
- 10 that the registration was not timely filed.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2007.
